Ruffled deep burgundy rose with a gold brush stroke on the lower lip petal. Opens 8 in good placement with 22 buds on a flowerhead of 27". Won miniature champion for me at our show. Will quickly become a leader in its class plus being an all-America selection. A super cutflower. L-\$6.00 M-\$5.50 Unit 1L,1M,1S,10blts-\$12.00 Parentage -Bryan Nicole X Rosie

FIESTA AMERICANA (Hartline '09) (227) 78 days

Lightly ruffled deep orange salmon with yellow in the middle and bright red lower lip markings, A Fiesta of color explosion. Opens 9 in formal placement with 22 buds on a 25-26" flowerhead. Can win at the shows in a weak deep orange class and a very good cutflower. L-\$6.00 M-\$5.50 Unit 1L,1M,1S,10blts-\$12.00 Parentage Fire Frenzy Open

HOLY MOLY (Hartline '09)(213) 75 days

Holy Moly is right. A dazzling color combination of light yellow on the outside of the floret with an explosion of deep red on the rest of the floret. Has great mechanics to win big at the shows. PURE POETRY (Hartline '09)(435) 80 days

Ruffled medium blue with a white throat. Opens 7 with 22 buds on a 26-27" flowerhead. Excellent novelty cutflower. L or M \$1.00

Stunning deep blue with a white throat. Opens 9 lightly ruffled florets on a 30" flowerhead, love it. L or M \$2.00

AUBREY LANE (Sprinkle '91) (312) 75 days

Clear light yellow with a deeper yellow throat. Opens 9 heavily ruffled florets in formal placement on a 30" flower head. Easy grower that can win at the shows and also performs quite well for cutflower. Beautiful smooth yellow. L-\$1.25 M \$1.00

BAKER'S DOZEN (Larus'62) (444) 80 days

Given the name because it holds thirteen florets open at once. Medium salmon with a light yellow throat. Still one of the best old timers. L or M \$2.00

Gorgeous light pink blending to almost white towards the center with lower petals a creamy yellow. Opens 9 heavily ruffled

BEAUTIFUL DREAMER II (Jones '91) (462) 80 days

Easy growing light to medium rose that's a cut flower and arranger's dream. Opens 8 well placed florets on tall heavy stems. L-\$1.00 M-\$0.75

Strong growing big white that opens 9 in formal placement with 24 buds on a flowerhead of 30" plus. This one has been overlooked. L-\$1.00 M - \$0.75

A robust growing medium blue with a purple feather in the throat. An All-America selection that opens 9 in formal placement on tall straight stems. Superb cutflower. L-\$1.00 M-\$0.75

Heavenly shade of soft, clean light blue that everyone loves to see. One of the best cutflower blues for us every year. L or M \$1.00

Beautiful medium blue with a deeper blue throat with white spears on top. Very healthy and super cutflower. L-\$1.25 M-\$1.00

BLUE SKY (Klutey '2000) (471) 80 days

Awesome light blue that deepens toward the edges of the petals with a white throat. Opens 8 in formal placement with 24 buds on 30" plus flowerheads. Can win at the shows and a super cutflower. L-\$1.00 M-\$0.75

BLUE SYMPHONY (Klutey '89)(485) 75 days

Medium violet-blue with a small white throat. Opens 8 ruffled florets in formal placement on flowerheads of 30" plus. One of the best blues for show. Smooth color. L or M \$1.00

Heavily ruffled light yellow with a blush of salmon and beautiful red lip markings. Opens 8-9 in formal placement with 24 buds on a 28" plus flowerhead. Has all the tools to win at the show and a super cutflower. L \$6.00 M \$5.00

BOBBIE ANN (Labrums '96)(460) 70 days

Very pretty pale rose that opens 9 lightly ruffled florets with 22 buds on a 30" flowerhead. L-\$1.50 M-\$1.25

Heavily ruffled pure white that opens 8 in formal placement on a 28" flowerhead, One of my favorites L or M \$2.50

BRILLIANCE (Frazee'02) (454) 80 days

Easy growing lightly ruffled bright red. Opens 10 on tall spikes L-\$1.00 M-\$0.75

BRYANNE NICOLE (Skolaski '91) (464) 80 days

A stunning shade of medium rose with a silvery blend. Opens 9 in formal placement with 24 buds on flowerheads of 30" plus. A superb cutflower. L or M \$1.00

CALIMERO (Konicek 2000) (436) 80 days

A heavy ruffled orange scarlet with a deeper color at the petal edges. Opens 9 in formal placement with 24 buds on a 28"-30" flowerhead. Good for show and cutflower. L-\$2.00 M-\$1.75

CALLIOPE (Bates '97)(425) 80 days

Heavily ruffled heavily subtended bright medium orange with white midribs and deep yellow lip petals which are almost completely covered by a heavily veined medium rose blotch. Opens 8 of 23 buds on flowerheads of 27". One of the best novelty oranges. L-\$1.00 M-\$.75

CANDRIKE (Konicek '95) (354) 85 days

Ruffled bright red that opens 8 of 23 buds in formal placement on flowerheads of 30". Excellent all-purpose red. L or M \$1.25

CANDY CANE (Fischer '92) (455) 80 days (AA)

Glowing, bright medium red with a network of white candy stripes written all over the face. Opens 5 well placed florets on a 26" flowerhead. A public favorite at the shows and in the garden. Well named. L-\$1.50 M-\$1.25

CENTURY MARK (labrums '02)(534) 75 days

Tall growing ruffled salmon with a yellow throat blotch. Opens 10 in formal placement on a 30" plus flowerhead. Good for show and cutflower. L or M \$1.50

CHANDELLE ROSE (Alleman '97)(465) 80 days

Ruffled medium rose with a creamy white throat. Opens 10 in formal placement on a 30" flowerhead. Good for show and cutflower. L-\$1.00 M-\$.75

CHLOE (Klutey '87)(326) 75 days

Attractive deep orange with a slightly lighter throat. Opens 9-10 ruffled florets in formal placement on 30" plus flowerheads.

Unique combination of lighter brown upper petals, deep brown lip petals and deep red spears in the throat. Opens 6-7 ruffled florets on a 24" flowerhead. Gotta love it. L \$1.50 M \$1.25

CROWN JEWEL (Grube '02) (455) 75 days

Glistening to medium deep red with a deep rose blotch in the center. Opens 10 in perfect placement with 26-28 buds on flowerheads of 36". A big winner at the shows and a super cutflower. L-\$4.00 M-\$3.50

CRYSTAL PALACE (Hartline '03) (400) 80 days

The next great white showflower. Perfect formed spikes of pure white that open 10 ruffled florets in very formal placement with

DANA (Kovarik-Lukestic '93) (343) 84 days

Heavily ruffled light pink sport of Bambino. Beautifully chiseled flower with great growing habits. One of the best heavily ruffled pinks. L-\$1.25 M-\$1.00

Every time I eat a creamsicle I think of delectable. A mouth watering cream with a tinge of green and mix of light peach.

Opens 8 heavy ruffled heavy subtended florets in good placement with 23 buds on a 28-30" flowerhead. Try a bite you'll love it. L-\$2.50 M-\$2.00

DENALI (Madeson '03) (300) 80 days

Beautifully ruffled pure white that opens 8-9 in perfect placement with 24 buds on 30" plus flowerheads. Great for show and cutflower. L-\$2.00 M-\$1.50

DICK'S DELIGHT (Bates '95) (455) 80 days

An extremely bright medium red with a large pure white throat. Opens 10 beautifully ruffled florets in perfect formal placement on flowerheads of 35". Tremendous grower for show and cutflower. One of our favorite reds. L-\$1.50 M-\$1.00

DIVINITY (Summerville '85) (500) 80 days

Heavily ruffled giant white that opens 9-10 in good placement with 23-24 buds on flowerheads of 30" plus. Still one of the best 500's. L or M \$2.00

Named after the late Doc Jones who gave us so many great introductions. Doc is a superb show flower. Pure white with white stamens. Opens 10 ruffled florets in perfect placement on a flowerhead of 32" plus. Wins for us whenever we show. One of the best. L or M \$1.50

DORIS DARLING (Hartline '96) (443) 80 days

Beautiful shade of light pink that opens 10 in perfect formal placement on flowerheads of 32" plus. Tremendous show flower that's winning big. One of the best. L-\$1.25 M-\$1.00

DOUBLE DELIGHT (Hartline '06) (432) 80 Days

Pale salmon with a deeper pink salmon in the throat. Opens 8 heavily ruffled heavy subtended florets with 26 buds on a 30" flowerhead. Petaloids in the center makes the florets appear double. Because it has long flowerheads on a shorter plant, the chances of it being blown over are very slim, which makes this one perfect for landscape borders and plantings. L-\$4.00 M-\$3.50

DOUBLE TAKE (Hartline '07)(311) 80 days

Tall heavily ruffled cream that opens 10 with 24 buds on a 30" flowerhead. Excellent for show and cutflower. L-\$2.50 M-\$2.25

DRAMA (MacKenzie '80) (453) 85 days

Mouth watering deep watermelon base color, blotched in the throat with an eye-catching bright yellow, brushed with red. Great for show and cutflower. Tall grower. L-\$1.00 M-\$.75

Awesome spike maker that makes championship spikes with ease. A gorgeous soft orange salmon with a beautiful light yellow throat.. Opens 9 ruffled heavily subtended florets in

DYNAMITE II (465) 85 Days

Very pretty blend of mauve rose with a light yellow throat. Opens 8 ruffled florets on a tall straight stems. Great cutflower. L_\$1.00 M-\$.75

EASY RIDER (Bates '98) (465) 75 days

An easy growing medium rose with a deep rose tongue on a white blotch. Opens 8 ruffled florets in great placement on flowerheads of 30". An excellent cutflower with great growing habits. L-\$1.00 M-\$.75

EMERALD ISLE (Frazee) (404) 80 days

A ruffled medium green that opens 8-9 with 22-23 buds in good placement on a tall straight stems. One of the better cutflower greens. Very healthy. L-\$ 1.00 M-\$.75

EMPIRE YELLOW (Rich 63) (412) 80 days

Still one of the best light yellows. Opens 8-10 lightly ruffled florets in formal placement on the flowerheads of 32" plus. One of my favorites. L OR M \$2.00

ESPERANTO (Bates '97) (311) 80 days

A striking blend of cream and yellow with a bold red explosion blotch. Opens 9 heavily ruffled florets, with 24-26 buds on a flowerhead of 27-28". One of the best tri-color glads for cutflower. L-\$1.00 M-\$.75

EXCLAMATION (Bates '99) (455) 80 days

Smooth medium rosy pink with a sharp crimson blotch in the throat. Opens 9 ruffled florets in formal placement on a flowerhead of 35" plus. One of the best of 1999. Huge grower. L-\$1.25 M-\$1.00

FANCY THAT (Hartline '06) (443) 80 Days

Striking pale pink with pinkish red markings on the lower petals and lip. Opens 11 heavily ruffled heavy subtended florets in formal placement with 24 buds on a 25-26" flowerhead. This one also has a shorter height which makes it perfect for landscape work. Great color, I love it. L-\$3.50 M-\$3.00

FIESTA (Griesbach '71) (327) 75 days

The upper portions of the florets are a vivid salmon-orange and the lower petals are bright yellow with an orange picotee margin. Great cutflower. Great show color. L -\$1.00 M- \$.75

FINAL TOUCH (Fairchild '94) (535) 90 days

Giant growing salmon pink with a large white throat. One of the best 500's for show and also a very good cutflower. L -\$1.25 M-\$1.00

FINESSE (Summerville '87) (435) 80 days

Smooth, clean light to medium salmon with a bright yellow throat. Consistently produces show caliber spikes. L or M \$1.00

FIREBALL II (Bates '94) (455) 75 days

A fiery medium red with a veined yellow throat. Opens 8 lightly ruffled florets in formal placement on a 33" flowerhead. An excellent cutflower with great growing habits. Interesting color. L-\$1.00 M-\$.75

FIRES OF SPRING (Bates '97) (433) 80 days

Classy light salmon with an awesome veined rose-red blotch. Opens 8 lightly ruffled florets in formal placement on a 30" plus flowerhead. An excellent all-purpose glad. Stunning color. L-\$1.25 M-\$1.00

FLAMENCO (Franklin '96) (426) 85 days

Glistening deep orange that sparkles in the garden. Opens 8-10 heavily ruffled florets in formal placement on the flowerheads of 33" plus. Has won numerous awards at the shows. L-\$1.50 M-\$1.00

FLORET OF FERN (Ciplijauskas '98) (473) 80 days

Lightly ruffled tall growing early blooming white that makes great spikes right down the row. One of Turks best. L-\$1.00 M-\$.75

An unusual and unique color combination of old rose and pale green. The green dominates almost all the lip petals and splashes on the upper petals and mid-ribs as well. Opens 8 ruffled florets in fine placement on a 27-28" flowerhead. L-\$1.00 M-\$.75

GLITTERING STAR (Repcik '92) (326) 75 days

Heavily ruffled, glistening deep orange with substance like wax. Excellent exotic. L-\$1.25 M-\$1.00

GOLDEN AGE (Summerville '83) (316) 90 days

Lightly ruffled deep yellow with a deeper yellow throat. Truly magnificent. Valuable hybridizing tool and a superb cutflower. L-\$1.00 M-\$.75

GOLDEN GLORY (MacKenzie '92) (514) 80 days

A tall robust growing light yellow that's done very well on the show table and is also an excellent cutflower. Beautiful round florets. L or M \$1.00

A heavily ruffled deep yellow that opens 9-10 in good placement with 24 buds on a 30" plus flowerheads. One of the better deep yellows. L-\$ 1.50 M-\$ 1.25

Rich golden yellow deepening in the center. Opens 9 beautifully ruffled florets in formal placement on a 33' flowerhead. L-\$1.00 M-\$.75

GOLDEN SUNSET (MacKenzie '93) (414) 70 days

Medium yellow that opens 9 ruffled florets in formal placement on flowerheads of 32" plus. An excellent early cutflower that can also win at the shows. L or M \$1.00

GOLD STRUCK (Adams '91) (416) 75 days

Beautiful deep golden yellow that opens 8 ruffled florets in fine placement on a 28-30" flowerhead. One of the best cutflowers we have ever grown. L-\$1.00 M-\$.75
